### ***Building Tomorrow's Cybersecurity Today***

#### **TUESDAY 5 JUNE**

**10:00-10:50 (Opening Keynote Presentation - presented by Baroness Dido Harding, Chair of NHS Improvement and former CEO, TalkTalk): *View from the Board: A CEO's Perspective on Cybersecurity*:** Exploring what a CEO really needs from the information security function, how to promote a security culture across the enterprise and how, in the event of a breach, to work with the CEO to minimise impact and protect the reputation of the organisation.

**12:00-12:40: *Security at the Speed of Business: Supporting Digital Transformation with Cybersecurity*:** As businesses rapidly innovate and embrace new technologies, a fast-paced culture is leading to an increasingly complex risk landscape. The panel will look at how there needs to be enough security to defend against threats, whilst avoiding excessive controls, to ensure innovation and growth is enabled. Panellists: Lee Barney, Head of Information Security, Marks & Spencer; John Meakin, CISO, GSK Technology and Graeme Hackland, CIO, Williams Grand Prix Engineering.

## **WEDNESDAY 6 JUNE**

**10:00-10:50 (Opening Keynote Presentation - presented by Baroness Martha Lane Fox, Co-Founder, Lastminute.com, Co-Founder & Executive Chair, Doteveryone): *Dystopia or Utopia? Privacy & Cybersecurity in the Digital Age*:** Exploring the privacy implications of our increasingly networked world and how they affect the work of the information security community.

**13:30 - 14:10: Keynote Special: Focus on Disruptive Technologies - *Friend or Foe? Can (and Will) AI & Machine Learning Stop Hackers? Or will AI be the Hacker?*:** As with any new technology, if it is not secure by design then the AI technology itself is also exposed to attack. So what is the reality of AI – will it deliver on its promise as a defensive tool to protect data? Or will AI become the hacker and simply become another risk in an already complex landscape? Panellist: Mikko Hypponen, a worldwide authority on computer security and the Chief Research Officer of F-Secure, will look at if AI is a cyber-friend or foe.

**14:30 - 15:10: *The Modern State of Insecurity*:** With online security in a constant state of flux; threats today are entirely new to those from only a year or two ago. Yet at the same time, we're still dealing with the same fundamental threats we were decades ago. In this talk, world-renowned internet security specialist Troy Hunt will demonstrate how these threats are evolving and which are the ones we need to be especially conscious of in the modern era. Panellist: Troy Hunt is a Microsoft Regional Director and MVP, Pluralsight author and the creator of "Have I Been Pwned", the free online service for breach monitoring and notifications.

**10:00-10:50: (Opening Keynote Presentation - presented by Robert Hannigan, former Director General, GCHQ): *Weaponising the Web: Nation-State Hacking & What it Means for Enterprise Cybersecurity*:** Robert Hannigan will discuss the reality of alleged nation-state sponsored cybercrime the risk to different types of organisations and how to mitigate that risk.

**13:25-14:25: *Partners in (Fighting Cyber) Crime: Building Collaboration Between Business, Government and Law Enforcement*:** Cybercrime is a robust global business. So how can organisations cut through conflicting priorities to work together effectively to fight cybercrime? What are the challenges of developing a co-ordinated international response to cyber-attacks and how can they be overcome? How can government and industry - not just CNI - share information and support each other more effectively? Panellists: Dr Victoria Baines, Principal, Cartimandua Insight; Paul Midian, CISO, Dixons Carphone; Scott Smith, Assistant Director, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Cyber Division and Ben Russell, Head of Cyber Intelligence, National Crime Agency.
